Owing to its frequently large pots, Omaha Hi/Lo (also called 'Omaha High Low', 'Omaha H/L', 'Omaha/8' or 'Omaha 8-or-better') has become a hugely popular game around the world. Each player in an Omaha Hi/Lo game is dealt four private cards ('hole cards') that belong only to that player. Five community cards are dealt face-up on the 'board'. All players use exactly two cards from their four hole cards in conjunction with exactly three cards from the board to make the best five-card poker hand possible. The pot is divided between the best hand for high and the best hand for low - hence the name, Omaha Hi/Lo. You may use different combinations of two cards from your hand to make your high hand and your low hand, but in each hand you must use precisely two from your hand and three from the board - no more, no less. Visit the poker hands page to view the rankings of hands in Omaha Hi/Lo.

Omaha Hi/Lo is played with an '8-or-better' qualifier, which means that a low hand must consist of five different cards - ranked eight or below - to be eligible to win the low portion of the pot. Low hands in Omaha Hi/Lo are determined in exactly the same way they're determined in 7 Card Stud Hi/Lo. If there is no qualifying low hand, the high hand wins the entire pot. Omaha Hi/Lo uses the 'Ace to Five' or 'California' system for ranking low hands. Straights and flushes do not count against a hand, and Aces are always low in reading the low hand, so the best possible hand is a "wheel": 5, 4, 3, 2, A. To help understand the ranks of low hands, the following sample qualifying low hands (not a complete list) are ranked from least powerful (#1, will rarely win the low half of the pot) to most powerful (#10, the nuts):

8, 7, 6, 5, 4 8, 7, 6, 5, 3 8, 6, 4, 2, A 8, 4, 3, 2, A 7, 6, 5, 4, 2 7, 6, 5, 2, A 7, 5, 4, 3, 2 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 6, 4, 3, 2, A 5, 4, 3, 2, A

Note that a low hand is always ranked from its highest card downwards. So for example, hand #9 is known as a 'Six-low' because its highest card is a Six. Hand #5 is a 'Seven-low', and Hand #1 is an 'Eight-low'. In poker slang, you distinguish between close low hands by going further down the ranks, so hand #9 would be called a 'Six-Four low', which beats hand #8, a 'Six-Five low'. Also remember that straights and flushes do not count against your low hand, so making a qualifying low that is also a straight or a flush is a very powerful hand, that could win both the high and low halves of the pot. That's called a 'scoop'.

Types of Omaha Hi/Lo Games

Omaha Hi/Lo can be played in the following formats:

Limit Omaha Hi/Lo - Specific betting limit applied in each game and on each round of betting.
- Specific betting limit applied in each game and on each round of betting. Pot Limit Omaha Hi/Lo
- Bets are limited to the amount of chips in the pot.
- Bets are limited to the amount of chips in the pot. No Limit Omaha Hi/Lo - A player can bet all of the chips he has available.
- A player can bet all of the chips he has available. Mixed Omaha Hi/Lo - The game alternates between rounds of Limit and Pot-Limit. The blinds are increased when the game switches from Pot-Limit to Limit, to ensure that the stake levels are consistent.

Rules for Playing Omaha Hi/Lo

In Omaha Hi/Lo, a marker called 'the button' or 'the dealer button' indicates which player is the nominal dealer for the current game. Before the game begins, the player immediately clockwise from the button posts the 'small blind', the first forced bet. The player immediately clockwise from the small blind posts the 'big blind', which is typically twice the size of the small blind, but the blinds can vary depending on the stakes and betting structure being played. In Limit games, the big blind is the same as the small bet, and the small blind is typically half the size of the big blind but may be larger depending on the stakes. For example, in a R\$2/\$4 Limit game the small blind is R\$1 and the big blind is R\$2. In a R\$15/\$30 Limit game, the small blind is R\$10 and the big blind is R\$15. In Pot Limit and No Limit games, the games are referred to by the size of their blinds (for example, a R\$1/\$2 Omaha Hi/Lo game has a small blind of R\$1 and a big blind of R\$2). Now, each player receives their four hole cards. Betting action proceeds clockwise around the table, starting with the player 'under the gun' (immediately clockwise from the big blind).

Pre-Flop

After seeing his or her hole cards, each player now has the option to play his or her hand by calling or raising the big blind. The action begins to the left of the big blind, which is considered a 'live' bet on this round. That player has the option to fold, call or raise. For example, if the big blind was R\$2, it would cost R\$2 to call, or at least R\$4 to raise. Action then proceeds clockwise around the table. Note: The betting structure varies with different variations of the game. Explanations of the betting action in Limit Omaha Hi/Lo, No Limit Omaha Hi/Lo, and Pot Limit Omaha Hi/Lo can be found below. Betting continues on each betting round until all active players (who have not folded) have placed equal bets in the pot.

The Flop

After the first round of betting is complete, the 'flop' is dealt face-up on the board. The flop is the first three community cards available to all active players. Betting begins with the active player immediately clockwise from the button. Another round of betting ensues. In Limit Omaha Hi/Lo, all bets and raises on the flop are in increments of the small bet (for example, R\$2 in a R\$2/\$4 game).

The Turn

When betting action is completed for the flop round, the 'turn' is dealt face-up on the board. The turn is the fourth community card in an Omaha Hi/Lo game. Play begins with the active player immediately clockwise from the button. Another round of betting ensues. In Limit Omaha Hi/Lo, bets and raises on the turn are in increments of the big bet (for example, R\$4 in a R\$2/\$4 game).

The River

When betting action is completed for the turn round, the 'river' is dealt face-up on the board. The river is the fifth and final community card in an Omaha Hi/Lo game. Betting begins with the active player immediately clockwise from the button. A final betting round ensues.

The Showdown

If there is more than one remaining player when the final betting round is complete, the last person to bet or raise shows their cards, unless there was no bet on the final round in which case the player immediately clockwise from the button shows their cards first. The player with the best five-card hand for high wins half the pot, and the player with the best five-card hand for low wins the other half. Remember, in all Omaha games, players must use two (and only two) of their four hole cards in combination with exactly three cards from the board. In the event of identical hands, the high and low shares of the pot will be equally divided between the players with the best hands. In the event that no hand qualifies for low (i.e. is an 'eight low' or better), the best hand(s) for high

wins the whole pot. After the pot is awarded, a new Omaha Hi/Lo game is ready to be played. The button now moves clockwise to the next player.

Limit, Pot Limit, No Limit Omaha Hi/Lo

Omaha Hi/Lo rules remain the same for Limit, No Limit and Pot Limit poker games, with a few exceptions:

Limit Omaha Hi/Lo

Betting in Limit Omaha Hi/Lo is in pre-determined, structured amounts. Pre-flop and on the flop, all bets and raises are of the same amount as the big blind. On the turn and the river, the size of all bets and raises doubles. In Limit Omaha Hi/Lo, up to four bets are allowed per player during each betting round. This includes a (1) bet, (2) raise, (3) re-raise, and (4) cap (final raise).

Betting in Limit Omaha Hi/Lo is in pre-determined, structured amounts. Pre-flop and on the flop, all bets and raises are of the same amount as the big blind. On the turn and the river, the size of all bets and raises doubles. In Limit Omaha Hi/Lo, up to four bets are allowed per player during each betting round. After that bet, the action moves to the next player clockwise. That player can either fold, call R\$100, or raise any amount between the minimum (\$100 more) and the maximum. The maximum bet in this case is R\$400 - the raiser would first call R\$100, bringing the pot size to R\$300, and then raise R\$300 more, making a total bet of R\$400. In Pot Limit Omaha Hi/Lo, there is no 'cap' on the number of raises allowed.

The minimum bet in Pot Limit Omaha Hi/Lo is the same as the size of the big blind, but players can always bet up to the size of the pot. The minimum bet in No Limit Omaha Hi/Lo is the same as the size of the big blind, but players can always bet as much more as they want, up to all of their chips.

Minimum raise: In No Limit Omaha Hi/Lo, the raise amount must be at least as much as the previous bet or raise in the same round. As an example, if the first player to act bets R\$5 then the second player must raise a minimum of R\$5 (total bet of R\$10).

Maximum raise: The size of your stack (your chips on the table).

In No Limit Omaha Hi/Lo, there is no 'cap' on the number of raises allowed.

On the PokerStars software, it's not possible to bet less than the minimum or more than the maximum. The bet slider and bet window will only allow you to bet amounts within the allowed thresholds. Omaha Hi/Lo is growing very fast in popularity, especially with the exposure of online poker. So while learning the rules of Omaha Hi/Lo can take some getting used to, it is an entertaining poker variant that many players have learned to enjoy.

Há um novo meme sendo compartilhado amplamente esta semana pix bet presidencial contas de mídia social na capital da Colômbia, Bogotá.

É uma imagem de C. Montgomery Burns, o supervilão da série animada "Os Simpson", aparecendo na porta com um monte das rosa e do coração pix bet presidencial forma caixa chocolate : Sorrindo ele diz que "eu vi pix bet presidencial vez d'água racionamento é diferente dos meus".

O meme reflete um senso de humor negro entre alguns Bogotânos

Na sequência do anúncio da autoridade municipal na segunda-feira, que os moradores teriam de racionar a água à medida pix bet presidencial seca alimentada pelo El Nio empurra reservatórios para mínimos recorde.

O racionamento entrou pix bet presidencial vigor na manhã de quinta-feira. Bogotá e dezenas das cidades vizinhas foram divididas por nove zonas diferentes com água corrente doméstica cortada durante 24 horas, numa rotação que será reiniciada a cada 10 dias as medidas afetarão aproximadamente 9 milhões pessoas;

Há planos de contingência para garantir que escolas e hospitais tenham um suprimento contínuo, disseram as autoridades.

Mas, como o meme "Os Simpsons" sugere alguns moradores ficaram se perguntando sobre a necessidade de começarem um encontro com amigos pix bet presidencial toda cidade para acessar água potável.

As medidas fazem parte dos planos de emergência introduzidos pelo governo colombiano e o prefeito da cidade depois que os reservatórios atingiram níveis "hitoriamente baixos".

Os reservatórios de Chuza e San Rafael, parte do Sistema Chingazá que fornece 70% da água potável na cidade estão pix bet presidencial posições particularmente críticas.

"Não vamos desperdiçar uma gota de água pix bet presidencial Bogotá neste momento", disse o prefeito Carlos Fernando Galán, acrescentando que isso nos ajudará a remover essas restrições mais rapidamente ou reduzir".

Galán pediu "uma mudança comportamental que seja sustentável ao longo do tempo e garante a água suficiente para todos", acrescentando ainda, pix bet presidencial alguns reservatórios tem menos de 20% da capacidade comparada com as médias históricas desta época.

Bogotá se junta à Cidade do México ao noroeste, o que também pode estar prestes a ficar sem água. A combinação de mudanças climáticas com El Nio e geografia coloca uma pressão imensa sobre seus recursos hídrico

Mas esta é a primeira vez na história recente que Bogotá foi forçada à implementação de medidas para racionamento da água.

Situada pix bet presidencial um planalto montanhoso, Bogotá é uma das capitais mais altas do

mundo a 2.600 metros (8.500 pés) acima da superfície marítima e ao leste estão os picos dos Andes; no oeste está o vale exuberante através de onde serpenteia Magdalena (maior rio colombiano), que constitui fonte vital d'água para todos nós!

Umidade das florestas tropicais ao longo da Magdalena sobe os vales de montanha e entra no bet presidencial confronto com as temperaturas mais frias no topo, gerando chuva.

Como todos os

Bogotá

sabe, a chuva é bastante comum na cidade que depende muito dela para suas necessidades de água.

"A maioria das cidades ao redor do mundo depende de aquíferos para o abastecimento da água. Bogotá é diferente, pois quase todo nosso suprimento vem de águas superficiais como reservatório e são mais suscetíveis aos padrões chuvosos", disse Armando Sarmiento professor na Universidade Javeriana (Bogotá).

É essa dependência da chuva que torna Bogotá particularmente vulnerável à seca, disse Sarmiento.

Desde o ano passado, a cidade tem experimentado longos períodos de seca devido ao impacto do El Niño.

El Niño é um padrão climático natural originário do Oceano Pacífico ao longo da linha equatorial, que influencia o clima em todo o mundo. Na Colômbia tem alimentado temperaturas mais altas ou chuvas menores

Em um país tão politicamente dividido como a Colômbia, o governo emitiu em janeiro uma decreta de desastre natural para mobilizar recursos no esforço contra seus efeitos devastadores.

Os planos de racionamento da água em Bogotá foram apoiados pelo presidente do país, que historicamente teve uma relação com o prefeito.

O Provedor de Justiça da Colômbia, uma autoridade civil encarregada de proteger os direitos civis e humanos emitiu um comunicado na terça-feira dizendo que o fornecimento confiável a longo prazo é direito humano básico. Em fevereiro do ano passado foi lançada pelo Ministério para Meio Ambiente com as hashtags #ElNiñoNoESUnJuego (El Niño não está no jogo) alertando aos colombianos sobre a separação de uma crise!

medida que o aquecimento global torna as condições climáticas extremas, como ondas de calor e seca mais comuns ou severas (e até mesmo intensas), especialistas alertam para a necessidade do aumento da pressão sobre os sistemas hídricos das cidades.

A ministra do Meio Ambiente da Colômbia, Susana Muhamad pediu às autoridades municipais que elaborassem planos de longo prazo para reduzir o abastecimento.

"Chegamos a um ponto em que não podemos esperar água para descer como costumava ser se nós respeitamos o ciclo de abastecimento natural dos reservatórios, Se você não respeitar os ciclos naturais da Água", disse ela aos repórteres na segunda-feira. Ela pediu uma força tarefa para limitar a expansão urbana em áreas naturais".

Sarmiento, o ecologista disse que embora seja difícil prever como é possível evoluir nos próximos anos tanto a cidade quanto os países precisam estar mais bem preparados para futuras crises em uma escala muito maior.

"Em momentos como este, todos se concentram em usos individuais", disse ele. Mas a questão é muito maior - acrescentou o especialista - especialmente Bogotá que também está entre as áreas industriais mais movimentadas da Colômbia".

"Precisamos repensar nosso uso da água como sociedade."
